What We Believe...

The Bible is the only inerrant, authoritative Word of God, and thus, the final authority in matters of faith and practice. (2 Timothy 3:16, 2 Peter 1:19-21)

There is one God, unbounded in all attributes and eternally existent in three persons: the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. (Deuteronomy 6:4, Matthew 28:19)

Jesus Christ is eternally God. He was born of a virgin as a man, lived a sinless life, performed miracles, vicariously atoned for sin by His death, provided salvation through His shed blood, rose bodily from the dead, ascended to the right hand of the Father, and will return bodily to earth to establish His earthly kingdom. (Hebrews 1:2, Matthew 1:21-23, Colossians 3:1)

The first man, Adam, was created to glorify and enjoy God, but he fell from this innocent state by sinning against God, bringing death and the penalty for sin to all people, and the deterioration of the cosmos. (Romans 5:12)

Lost and sinful man can be regenerated only by the Holy Spirit by grace through faith alone. (John 3:3-8, Ephesians 2:8-9, Acts 16:31)

Both the saved and the lost will be resurrected—the saved unto the resurrection of life, and the lost unto the resurrection of damnation. (John 5:28, 1 Corinthians 15:52-53, Revelation 20:12-15)

The Holy Spirit indwells Christians and enables us to live a Godly life. (Galatians 5:16, Romans 8:14-27)

All believers in our Lord Jesus Christ are joined in the unity of the Holy Spirit. (John 17:21-23, 1 Corinthians 12:13)
